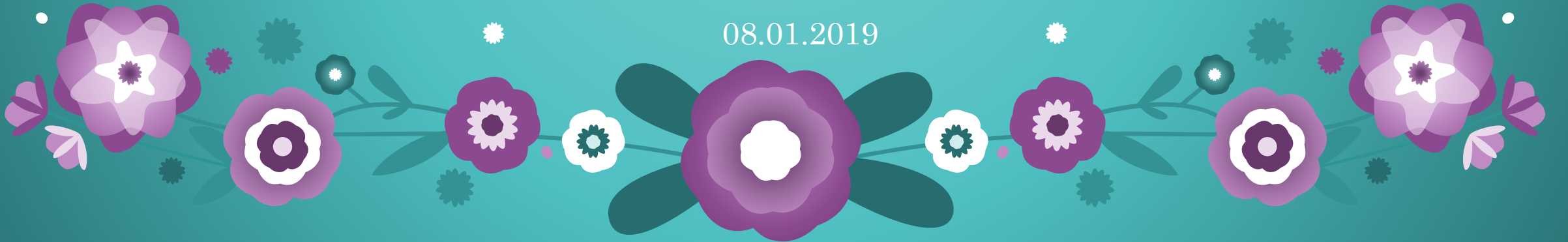

Child Abuse

- Any act or failure to act by a parent or other caregiver that results in
 - actual or potential harm to a child, and
 - can occur in a child's home, or in the organizations, schools or communities the child interacts with.

The Statistics

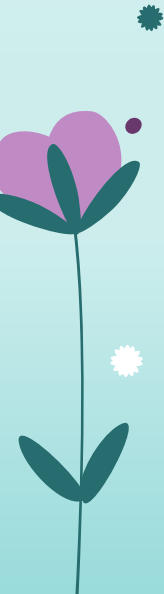
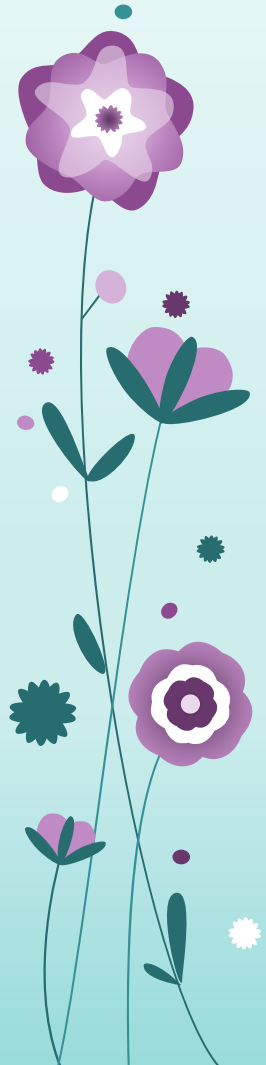
□ In 2017, 3445 child abuse cases reported in Pakistan

- Girls: 60% (1,077) & Boys: 40% (1368) .
- abduction, missing children, rape, sodomy, attempt of rape, gang sodomy, gang rape and child marriages.
- Punjab: 63%; Sindh: 27%;
Balochistan:4%; KP:2%; ICT:3%;
AJK=12%; GB:3%
- R=76%; U=24%



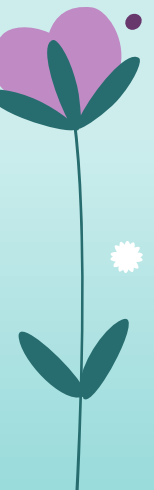
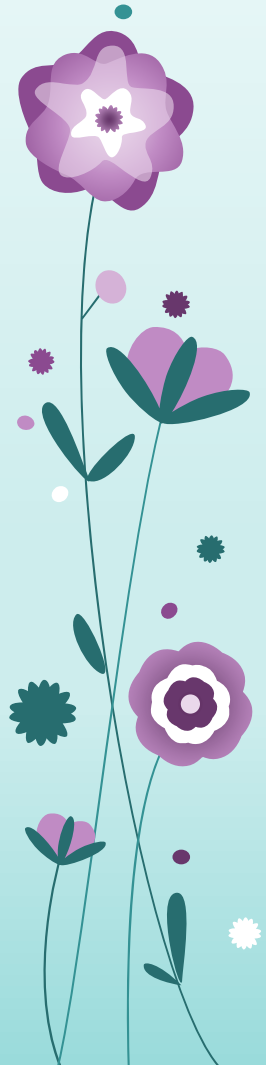
The Statistics

- The Abusers
 - Family members: 55%
 - Relatives/ friends: 30%
 - Strangers: 15%



KP CHILD PROTECTION AND WELFARE ACT, 2010 (Amend 2016,2018).

- ❖ To provide for the **care, protection, maintenance, welfare, training, education, rehabilitation and reintegration** of Children at risk in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.



KP CHILD PROTECTION AND WELFARE ACT, 2010 (Amend 2016,2018).

“CHILD AT RISK” means a child in need of protection who;

- i. is at risk, including an orphan, child with disabilities, child of migrant workers, child working and or living on the street, child in conflict with the law and child living in extreme poverty;
- ii. is found begging; or
- iii. is found without having any home or settled place of abode or without any ostensible means of subsistence; or
- iv. has a parent or guardian who is unfit or incapacitated to exercise control over the child; or
- v. lives in a brothel oror is found to associate with any prostitute or any other person who leads an immoral or depraved life: or

vi) is being or is likely to be abused or exploited for immoral or illegal purposes or gain; or

(vii) is beyond the parental control; or

(viii) is imprisoned with the mother or born in jail;

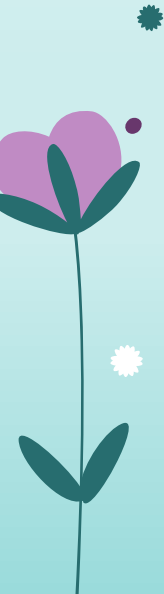
(ix) has lost his parents or one of the parents and has no adequate source of income; or

(x) is victim of an offence punishable under this Act or any other law for the time being in force and his parent or guardian is convicted or accused for the commission of such offence; or

(xi) is left abandoned by his parent or parents as the case may be, which will include a child born out of wedlock and left abandoned by his parent;

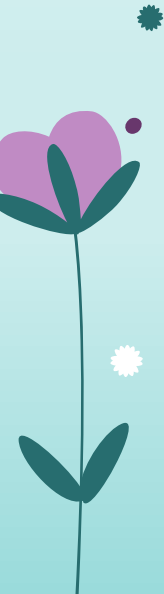
Offences and Penalties

□ Corporal Punishment

- imprisonment for a term which may extend to **six months** or with fine which may extend to **fifty thousand rupees**, or with both.

□ Fraud or deceit on a child

- imprisonment for a term which may extend to **three years** or with fine which may extend to **one hundred thousand rupees** or both



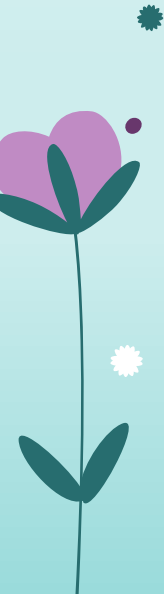
Offences and Penalties

□ Violence against a child

- imprisonment for a term which may extend to **three years** and with fine which may extend to **one hundred thousand rupees**

□ Harmful And Abusive Practices

- imprisonment for a term which may extend to **three years** or fine which may extend to **one hundred thousand rupees** or both.



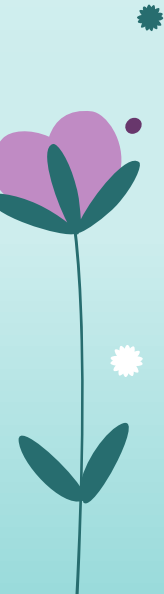
Offences and Penalties

□ Exposure to seduction

- rigorous imprisonment of either description for a term which may extend to **seven years** or liable to fine which may extend to **ten hundred thousand rupees**, or with both

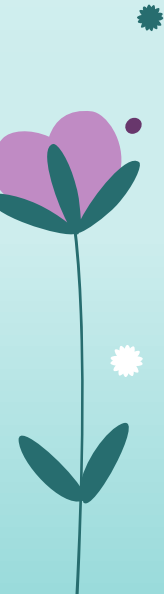
□ Sexual abuse

- imprisonment for a term which may extend to **fourteen years** and shall not be less than seven years and shall also be liable to fine which shall not be less than **ten hundred thousand rupees**.
